The Jersey Care Model appears to be pushing government responsibilities onto the third sector and in my opinion, those preparing this model lack an understanding of what services these charities actually provide.

Ensuring our young people receive an education to enable them to meet their full potential, including vocational and technical training where possible on the Island. Encourage employers to embrace succession planning within their businesses and organisations

Population and housing, these go hand in hand and are addressed in JLC's manifesto. Difficult decisions lay ahead for the next Assembly. JLC have the stamina to address this.
